• The last thing most families want to do during the grieving process is learn to become webmasters, enter content themselves almost constantly over the first weeks, respond with a warm thank you to thoughtful contributors to the site and moderate the spam comments made on the site. **We take over the full webmaster burden of setup and administration** for our clients. Our packages can include releases on obituary websites and across social media channels, with search engine optimization to make your site findable on Google, Yahoo! and Bing.
